

I-MILES is a critical component to live force-on-force training capability that impacts the overall training effectiveness for units to operate in a training environment. Ensuring the systems remain available, operational and concurrent with evolving technology for the next 30 years is essential.

The I-MILES Relevancy Contract-Full & Open is an effort to address I-MILES relevancy as (1) IMILES product line systems approach end of useful life (beyond economically repairable), (2) platform and weapon systems technologies continue to evolve, and (3) Army - Tactical Engagement Simulation System (A-TESS) capabilities requirement implementation is delayed.

The contract will address required MILES component replacement issues that occur as Live Training Engagement Composition (LTEC)/Live Player Area Network (LPAN) software matures. The contract(s)will replace Legacy MILES components that reach EUL/BER.


